DISTRICT LODGE 140 BYLAW AMENDMENT

Dear Brothers and Sisters:

At the District Lodge 140 Annual Convention in Halifax held October 23-25, the Delegates in attendance were able to agree unanimously on the proposed amendment that has been under discussion over the past 3 years. There has been a pursuit by the Western LL to have the DL 140 Bylaws amended to provide a General Chairperson to be located in and elected along provincial and territorial boundaries within the Western Region.

The Western Region is the largest geographic Region and has the most geographically dispersed Local Lodges and membership within Transportation District 140. There has been a stated desire within the Western Region to replace the existing Transportation District 140 Bylaws governing the nomination and election of General Chairpersons in this Region.

The fundamental desire has been achieved by the Delegates at this year's Convention. All locations within the Western Region have succeeded to obtain the representation they requested. With respect to Manitoba the article now will read:

11.01.09 (new)

- (a) There shall be one (1) designated Western Region General Chairperson for Manitoba, Saskatchewan, Thunder Bay and Cold Lake who shall be nominated by and elected At Large by only those members who are employed in and whose Local Lodge is located in Manitoba, Saskatchewan, Thunder Bay or Cold Lake. Members represented by the designated Manitoba, Saskatchewan, Thunder Bay and Cold Lake General Chairperson shall not be eligible to vote for any other General Chairpersons in the Western Region.

Local Lodge 714 is pleased to inform our members that as we move forward our Local will continue to maintain a General Chairperson representing our Membership.
