- 2) Third reading of DL140 Bylaw Proposal Amendment will take place.
Currently:

5.04 Each region shall have three Board Members. One (1) member from Air Transport, one (1) member from Transportation Service and one (1) member at large. Each region shall hold a "regional caucus" during the Convention, attempting to reach consensus on their Board members. Failing consensus, the delegates to the Convention will cast the deciding ballot. In the Eastern Region the member at large must reside on one of the four Atlantic Provinces (New Brunswick, Prince Edward Island, Nova Scotia,

Newfoundland and Labrador) as well as be a member in good standing of a District 140 Local Lodge in Atlantic Canada.

Section 5.04 Amendment.

Each region shall have three (3) Board Members.

One (1) from Air Transport, one (1) from Transportation Service, one (1) from Airport Screeners. In the Eastern region where there are no screeners there will be an at large position.

In the Eastern Region, the Member at large must reside on one of the following four Atlantic Provinces (New Brunswick, Prince Edward Island, Nova Scotia, Newfoundland, and Labrador) as well as be a member in good standing of a District 140 Local Lodge in Atlantic Canada.

In the Western Region, there must be one Executive board member that resides in one of the following: Manitoba, Saskatchewan, Thunder Bay and Cold Lake.

There must be one member that resides in one of the following the province of Alberta and the Northwest Territories.

There must be one member that resides in one of the following the province of British Columbia and the Yukon Territories.

As well as be a member in good standing of a District 140.

Each region shall hold a "regional caucus" during the Convention, attempting to reach consensus on their Board Members. Failing consensus, the Delegates to the Convention will cast the deciding ballot.

And amend all other pertinent bylaws.

Reason for Amendment:

To give the Airport Screeners and their large Membership in the Western and Central Regions a seat on the Executive Board, while also giving the all the Provinces and Territories in western Canada a seat. Currently there is no representation on the Board from the Province of Alberta to the city of Toronto on the Eboard
